GRADING POLICY

2009 - 2010 School Year

ATTITUDE – 10%

Your attitude directly affects the level of your performance. Behavior in class and during a performance is one of the most important issues in determining your grade. A student with a good attitude will strive to perform to the best of their ability. Whether in the band room or on the auditorium stage, a student with the care and concern for the entire band, will perform with great success. Attitude is everything!

CLASS PARTICIPATION – 10%

The following equipment is necessary for a successful evaluation.

- a. *Working instrument*
- b. *Proper accessories (reeds, oil, mouthpiece, neck strap, etc.)*
- c. *Method book (Essential 2000) Book 2 or Book 3*
- d. *Pencil required for all rehearsal*
- e. *Band music for concerts and festivals*
- f. *Concert Attire*
(Black pants, black socks, black shoes, and a white Short sleeve polo shirt with a collar. Absolutely no tennis shoes or sandals of any form.)
- g. *Classroom attire – guidelines from the student handbook*

PERFORMANCE – 40%

All students are **required** to attend and participate at the evening concerts and MSBOA Festivals. Students will receive a concert schedule the first full day of class. It is the responsibility of the student to take the grading policy and concert schedule home. These events are **mandatory** for members of any Marysville Middle School band. Participating at scheduled band concerts will represent 40% of your grade. Failure to attend the concert or festivals will result in a grade deduction.

ABILITY – 40%

All students will be required to perform their instrument in front of the class. There will be a minimum of three playing examinations per nine weeks. Students will receive the materials for the playing exam one week in advance. Materials used for the exam will be exercises from their method book or the band music rehearsed during class time.
